

Deer Fence Extension **Review Checklist**

A permit application will not be accepted unless all of the following items are submitted or completed with:

1. Submit completed application form filled out with all pertinent information including the specific type of project and signed by applicant.
2. Plan review fee of \$100 shall be paid at the time the application is submitted.
3. Site Plan – Two (2) copies are required. Site plan shall be drawn to a scale of 1/8"=1'-0" or 1"=10'.

The following information must be shown or noted on the plan:

- a. North Arrow.
 - b. Footprint of residence.
 - c. Show property lines, utility easements, building setbacks, fence lines, adjacent properties, and street.
 - d. Any other pertinent existing improvements.
 - e. Show all existing trees and canopies on the lot.
 - f. Show the location of the proposed deer fence extensions and specify height of existing fence and proposed extensions.
4. All deer fence extensions shall match the existing ornamental metal fence that is black for the north and Navajo white for the south.
 5. All deer fence extensions shall match the existing fence post size – no exceptions.
 6. No deer fence extensions shall be allowed to exceed the maximum height of 6'-0".
 7. The translucent poly-line filament shall be white or cream in color. No other color shall be allowed – no exceptions.
 8. The translucent poly-line filament shall be a minimum diameter of 3/32" and a maximum diameter of 5/32" – no exceptions.
 9. Wire is not permitted for the deer fence extensions. The translucent poly-line filament must be free of wire also.
 10. The owner must submit a sample of the proposed translucent poly-line filament to be used to the Architectural Manager.
 11. See the attached deer fence extension standards for complete requirements.
