

Rancho Murieta Association's Social Media Policy

The Rancho Murieta Association (RMA) has contracted with the Nabr Communications Network (Nabr Network) as its sole source of communicating to RMA members and residents. The purpose of RMA's online media participation is to promote RMA activities and inform clubs, non-profit organizations, members, and residents about issues within the homeowner association itself. RMA will refrain from utilizing other sources of social media such as NextDoor, Facebook, Twitter, or any other type of media source except to refer residents to the Nabr Network.

This policy outlines the responsibilities for using the Nabr Network by the RMA Board, staff, committees, clubs, non-profit organizations, and RMA members and residents regarding the use of social media.

The detailed Terms of Use for RMA members and residents are provided by the Nabr Network making its website available to the community. All users of the Nabr Network must accept the Nabr Network Terms of Use.

The following is a summary of the Terms of Use:

1. Only authorized groups, members, and residents of the community (Users), as solely determined by RMA, are allowed to post information.
2. Users shall not allow non-residents and/or non-owners access to Nabr Network's members-only portion by sharing their login information.
3. Users shall not post, publish, upload, distribute, or disseminate any communications that are inappropriate, profane, defamatory, obscene, indecent, abusive, unlawful, or otherwise tortious.
4. Users shall not post content that attacks people based on race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, or disabilities.
5. Users shall not use the Nabr Network in connection with pyramid schemes, chain letters, junk mail, spamming, or any duplicative or unsolicited messages, commercial or otherwise.
6. Users shall not share their login ID or password with anyone else. If there are multiple users in the same household, each user must have a separate household account with a different email address. The system does allow for numerous household accounts which can be set up in the primary user's account profile.

RMA reserves the right to restrict access to the Nabr Network system to any group, member, or resident who violates these terms, at any time, and at its sole discretion.
